

# FRAME THINGS DIFFERENTLY



Experiment with using frames in your photographs.





Play with finding natural frames in the landscape and environment around you.

### PHOTOGRAPH UNEXPECTED OBJECTS



Look for objects that capture your attention.

Consider composition.

How will you frame the object? Look out for colour matches.



#### **SHARE MEMORIES**



What are your favourite memories of littlehampton?

Take a printed photograph to your favourite place.

Use an image from your family album or place your mobile phone within the landscape and share your favourite memory.

#### **CAPTURE MOVEMENT**



Find moments of movement while exploring the town.

What happens when you move while taking a photograph?

Set your camera on a timer and run past the lens or shake your camera while taking an image.





#### **PLAY WITH SHADOWS**



Go for a walk with your camera when the sun is out and make a portrait of your favourite place in shadows.



What happens if you take a photo of the same place in the morning and the evening or throughout the day?

## **LOOK FOR NATURE IN TOWN**





Look around you to see where nature and the town meet or clash.

Look for things growing in unusual places.
